Philippines holds within itself the charm of a queen, the power of a king and the solidarity of a knight. It enthralls the traveller in every aspect with its royal capacities. A one-on-one interaction with this lovely country must figure on your bucket list for the simple reason that a Philippines visa starts from INR 4,599 and get it in just 7 working days approx .

Documents for Philippines Visa application:

- **Original passport** and old passports, Passport should be valid for at least 6 months from the return date of travel, with a minimum of two blank pages.
- **Visa Application form** The form should be printed and filled on a single sheet of paper using both sides.
- **The photograph** pasted on the application form has to be crossed signed by the applicant.
- Credit Card Copy or Foreign Exchange with USD500 minimum.
- **Photo Specification:** Two recent 50mm x 50mm photographs with 80% face coverage and white background. The photograph must not be used in any form prior to the application for visa and should not be older than 6 months.
- Original **covering letter** from applicant stating the applicant's name, designation, passport details, all travel details with purpose and duration of visit. The letter should be duly signed by the applicant with his contact details and addressed to 'Philippines Consulate .
- **Bank statement** reflecting transactions of last 6 months, with bank seal and sign on each page, having minimum balance of 1 lakh rupees per applicant.
- **Salary slip** for last three months with company seal.
- If the applicant is self employed, he/she must submit their company registration copy or partnership deed. In case the applicant is employed in a firm, he/she must submit the original leave sanction from the company, duly signed by the authorized signatory with his name, designation and company stamp.
- **Hotel confirmation** as per travel itinerary.
- The confirmed return **air ticket** showing travel itinerary.

The photo that is submitted for the visa application should not be used in any form prior to the application for Philippines visa. It must not be tampered with in any form.

The photograph pasted on the form with a cross signature.

Form should be printed back to back.

The covering letter must be on company letter head if the applicant is self employed, and on plain paper if he/she is an employee of any firm.

Visa fees is non refundable, in case of rejection or any issues pertaining to passport withdrawal before visa processing.

If applicant is staying in more than one hotel during his stay in Philippines, he/she must submit day to day itinerary along with proof of hotel booking.

If a minor is travelling without any adult accompanying him, a NOC is to be submitted on a INR 100 stamp paper with Notary, which must be duly signed by the parent along with the parent's passports.

If deemed necessary, the consulate might ask for additional documents.
